CASE HISTORIES

- Case 1. 25 year old female from Poland. Obese. Right abdominal pain. Indurated lesion at incisura on endoscopy.
- Case 2. 36 year old female. Diarrhoea and weight loss. Hypoalbuminaemia. Punctuate ulceration with white plaques in duodenum. Duodenal biopsies
- Case 3. 71 year old female. Multiple gastric and colonic polyps. ? adenomas
- Case 4. 57 year old male. History of coeliac disease. On imaging mesenteric lymphadenopathy. At laparotomy, stricture in ileum 30 cm from ileocaecal valve.
- Case 5. 45 year old male. Anaemia. Small gastric polyps, stomach did not distend easily. Gastric biopsies
- Case 6. 23 year old male. Intermittent food bolus obstruction in mid oesophagus for 8 years, confirmed by radiology. On endoscopy, corrugated oesophageal mucosa that tears easily. Oesophageal biopsies
- Case 7. 65 year old male. History of upper abdominal pain. No other significant history. At endoscopy, a moderate gastritis was seen and random biopsies were taken.
- Case 8. 74 year old male. Gastric polyp. Large antral polyp snared.
- Case 9. 58 year old male. Operation for acute perforating appendicitis. History of alcoholism, epilepsy, aspiration pneumonia. On anti-epileptics.
